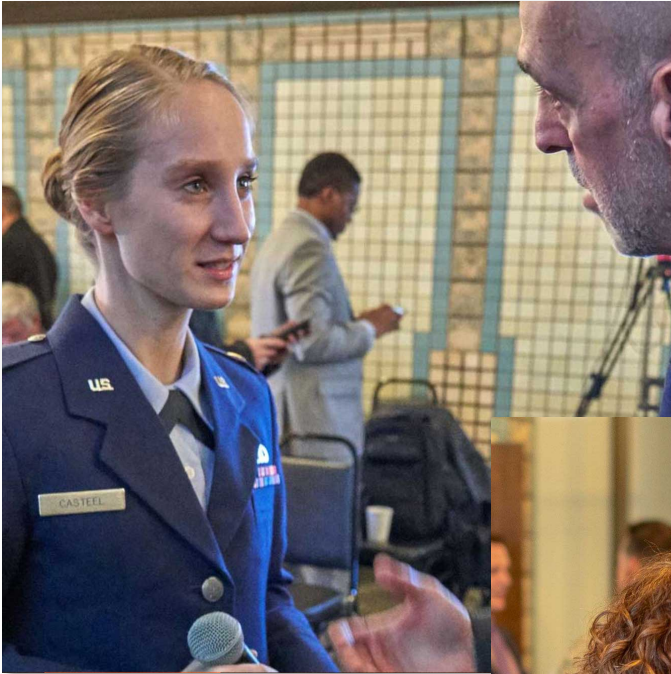
OUR VISION

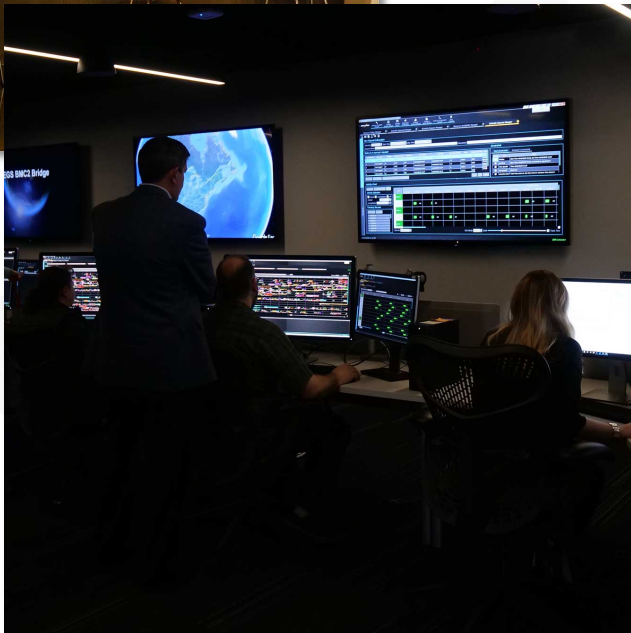
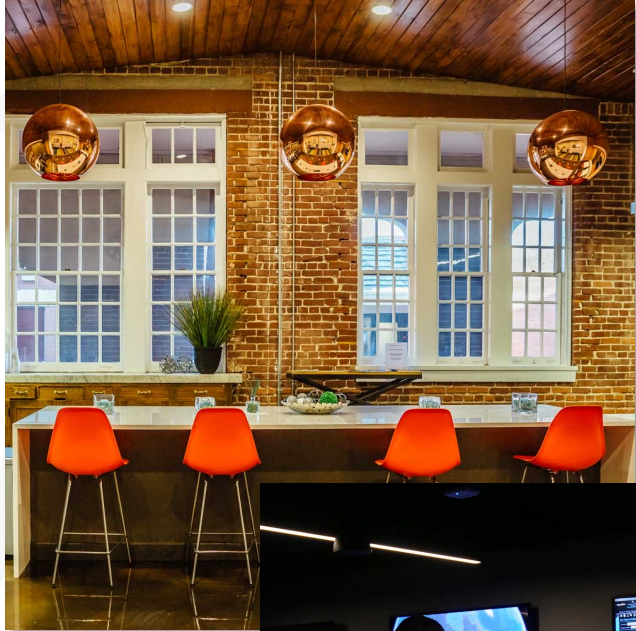

Catalyst Campus for Technology and Innovation (CCTI) manages and staffs the facilities, providing space and talented support staff to meet our customers' diverse requirements.

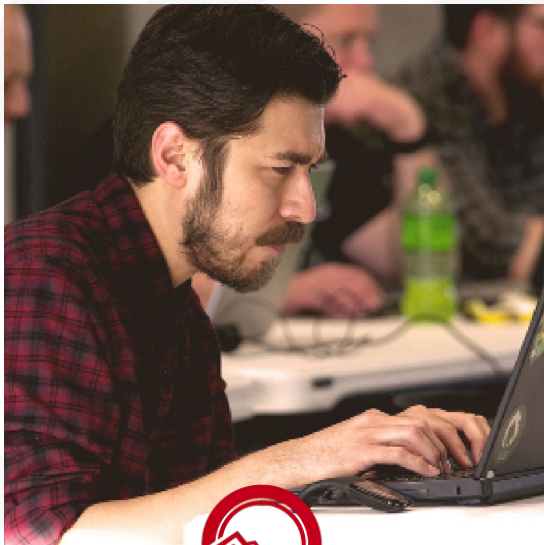


C-TRAC provides programmatics, recruiting and execution of on-campus and off-campus programs and initiatives.

The business nurturing activity at Catalyst Campus has naturally drawn a variety of workforce development and business support services, which are actively engaged with a number of Campus residents and programs.

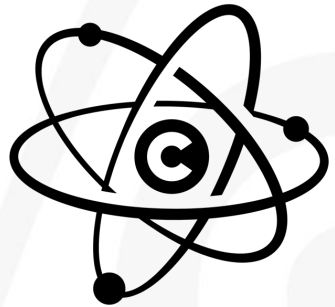
